3	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: I would like to

7	A.G. BALDERAS: Okay. Item No. 24
8	would you mind referencing the department? Is that
9	APD?
10	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Yes, sir.
11	Case 20-022.
12	A.G. BALDERAS: Okay. We'll reflect that
13	change to the agenda. And I am also showing if
14	before the disciplinary complaints, I'm showing
15	eight items. Is everyone kind of on the same page
16	with that?
17	(Board Members indicate).
18	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Chair Balderas?
19	A.G. BALDERAS: Yes.
20	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Second item to be
21	requested tabled would be the approval of the
22	meeting minutes from August 19th; we have not
23	received them yet. That's Item 3.
24	A.G. BALDERAS: Okay. We'll strike
25	Item 3. We're down to seven items. Any more



1	changes, Director?
2	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: No, sir.
3	A.G. BALDERAS: Okay. If there is no more
4	discussion, I'll now entertain a motion to approve
5	the agenda as amended, which would now include seven
6	items in addition to Item No well, in addition
7	to the pending disciplinary complaints, also
8	reflecting striking Case No. 24 20-022. I'll
9	entertain a motion to approve the agenda as amended.
10	DR. GREEN: Mr. Chair, this is Bobbie
11	Green. I make a motion that the agenda be approved
12	as amended.
13	A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you, Dr. Green.
14	There is a motion to approve agenda as
15	amended by Dr. Green.
16	Is there a second?
17	SERGEANT ANDERSON: Second. Hollie
18	Anderson. I'll second.
19	A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you, Sergeant
20	Anderson.
21	There is a motion and a second. We can
22	now entertain a roll call vote for approval.
23	MS. MEDRANO: Balderas.
24	A.G. BALDERAS: In favor.
25	MS. MEDRANO: Tedrow.





ITEM NO. 4: CHAIR'S REPORT

A.G. BALDERAS: We can now go to the -
Item No. 4 is Chairman's Report. My report is

rather brief.

I would like to maybe address a couple of issues that I think we've been dealing with over the course of everyone's tenure on the Board. I'd like to maybe follow up and -- and request from the Director, maybe at the next meeting, just an update, or a follow-up if, the director is adequately prepared to give an update today, I'd rather maybe push it to the next meeting.

But I do think that the Board would benefit from the follow-up on the progress of the biennium training requirements relating to the database. I know there was a lot of discussion and a lot of good work moving in the right direction to modernize the database. And so I think, you know, at a later date -- or, rather, isolated or detailed update -- would be helpful.

Additionally, I know that there is considerable support for the -- from the Board to identify personnel classifications and understaffing challenges. I know that's a common theme from the Director and management. And so if there's anything



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that can be identified where we can be more supportive -- and, of course, obviously, last discussion was very helpful in -- in really trying to build out a stronger system so that we can support, really, mitigating or minimizing a backlog of cases, not just in the investigation, but even at the AG's office, we have experienced, you know, volumes of cases. Some months, we'll get no cases; other months, we'll get a referral of 25 cases at once.

So I do think if we can keep that dialogue, Director, and, if -- again, if it's more appropriate at the next meeting, I think that the Board is definitely hungry for ways that we can be more supportive in those areas.

Finally, I know that coming in the session, Director, it would be really productive and helpful, we're anxious to see how the budget process is looking. I know there were some deadlines last couple of weeks. But as we get closer to LFC recommendations in January, it will be helpful to get some updates on the special appropriation request, especially for the job task analysis.

And then I'll also make my staff -- or request my staff give the Board an update on our



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special request for more prosecutors in the enforcement of these -- of these case actions that come over to our office.

And then, finally, I guess, you know, I want to maybe continue our focus. Many past boards have had the -- sometimes the -- both the privilege, and sometimes the luxury, of just focusing on training issues and on licensing issues and discipline issues. But as all of us have, you know, followed the news, and even last meeting, while the Board was serving and the Director was providing information and reporting on standard issues, there was an emergency situation in Albuquerque. That's where Sergeant Anderson and the Chief were called out in an active shooting situation.

And so these -- these issues, it would be good, by the end of the year, to -- and I know I have appointed a subcommittee. But I do think that any law enforcement reform or criminal justice reform that the Legislature either considers or evaluates, you know, I'm real hopeful that the Board, in a unified manner, we can provide our feedback and input on some of these bills and legislative.

I do think that there is going to be more



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attention given. But it would be a real travesty if this board didn't feel compelled to at least weigh in.

And I'm not asking for a lot of time commitment, and I'm not asking for a lot of research and diligence. But it would be nice for the Board for us to -- at least to decide what we're unified on in terms of where there should be increased resources, and maybe some ideas and legislation that the -- that are prioritized.

And so I just think that this board has a lot of experience. And I do think that -- and my staff is willing to synthesize and just take your input and maybe try to synthesize it into a position paper or a letter from our Board just identifying for the Governor and the Legislature areas of need that -- so I offer that up.

And I just think, in the Chair's Report, that -- that, regrettably -- I don't think you can separate licensing issues; I don't think you can separate law enforcement staffing levels; and I don't think you can address training in a vacuum when you consider other reforms.

And so that's just my pitch to the Board.

If Jerri calls you or, you know, tries to





poll you on your interest on certain ideas, please, you know, speak freely. We'll protect your -- your professional integrity. But what we're trying to do is synthesize and maybe create a letter before January to just broadly call attention some blind spots that the Legislature might not be considering.

Because the LEAB, I think, is one of the most important functions, and, yet, I think there's a lot of mystery as to our process. But I really think you are all leaders in -- in these very difficult topic areas that I think now, for some reason, the Legislature, I think, is going to go the opposite direction.

And I think they're going to -- they're going to be rather aggressive in trying to make changes or -- and I just want to make sure the LEAB is at the very top of respected authorities that -- based on your experience as to seeing patterns of law enforcement misconduct or where you've seen training needs, I think you guys are subject matter experts right off the bat.

So it's going to be up to me and my staff to kind of figure out what the priorities are of the Board. But I think, regrettably, we're in an era where I think the LEAB can no longer be considered



just a ministerial function that the Legislature or other areas are unaware of this very function.

I think -- I think this Board is probably one of the most important boards, especially when you talk about funding or public safety demands, on both sides, for citizens, and also what you want law enforcement to look like in 10, 15, 20 years.

You all are the experts, I think. And I just don't see how we can just focus on our licensing and our discipline issues and stay silent. I think it would be a very big travesty if we don't somehow put out, before January, just some kind of solidarity or areas of need that we -- we have observed ourselves.

And I think -- I think that's my pitch.

So that's -- that's -- Jerri and my staff will

probably be reaching out to you as we get closer to

the legislative session coming up in January.

That's fairly all. I just wanted to convey our support to the law enforcement community, in the past month, in the demands that have been occurring in the State of New Mexico, and then just give everyone a courtesy that we might be reaching out just to -- to synthesize a legislative agenda maybe in terms of what areas that the Legislature



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should focus. 1 2 So without that -- with all of that, I 3 should say -- I'll now move us along to the 4 Director's Report. 5 And you have the floor, Director. ITEM NO. 5: DIRECTOR'S REPORT 6 7 DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Thank you, Chair. can touch on each of those topics briefly right now. 8 But if you'd prefer, I can have something more 9 10 prepared for next meeting. 11 A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you. 12 DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: The biennial training update, working with ACADIS, it's just slow going. 13 14 We've gotten things that we now know that -- that we can do and the program can do. But our staffing 15 16 is -- is slowing it down. 17 If there is a glitch in the system -- I 18 can give you an example. We -- when we -- after a 19 meeting, after you-all have ratified certifications, 20 so we go to e-mail those certifications out. 21 this last time around, half of the people don't get 22 them. 23 And it's not a glitch with the database.



It's the interaction between the database and the

193 different agencies who have different IT setups.

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We don't have an IT person here. And if something like that happens, our deputy director basically has to stop everything he's doing. And this has been since early July was the first one. And I've got three or four staff members that just do that, that are doing three or four jobs. And to do -- to focus on putting out a fire that needs to be addressed right then, then literally everything else they're doing stops.

So the program is awesome. We're getting a lot of forward-moving progress on the ability to track stuff. It's now just that we don't have the staff to make it all happen.

After we initiated getting the agencies the capability to enter their rosters and update them, we had a backlog of other 4,000 entries, because everybody started entering them. And they have to be reviewed and verified initially. Once the process gets going, they can upload. But those are just two examples of what the staffing issues are causing.

I think the other -- the other ones, I'll wait and give you a better -- a more in-depth update at the next meeting.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you.





DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Currently, our hiring, we're still in hiring processes for instructors, a training coordinator, a compliance officer, and a misconduct case manager position.

One of those positions -- I apologize, it's either the instructor or the case manager position -- was frozen at the end of -- of the fiscal year, June 30th. So we can't hire that one until it's unfrozen.

I traveled last week. I was in Kosovo and then North Macedonia. I was working with IADLEST.

I am the accreditation committee chair.

And we handle two different areas of accreditation. We accredit police academies like ours, or standards, best practices, that we go in and audit agencies who have requested to receive that accreditation. It works here in the United States, but we also have international academies who request that.

So I was part of a group that went over and did the audit functions for the Kosovo police department and the North Macedonia police department.

And I was thankful for the opportunity to do that, because a lot of the theory that we work



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off of and what we think is important here, it was good to put it into practice and to see how those evaluations and audits are done.

Both of those agencies did receive accreditation. The Kosovo agency received an award of excellence for meeting the standards.

In that context, it's tough to meet those standards. It's something I would like to do for our academy and put that out as an option to our satellite academies, because each of them would have to apply individually, because their academy, you know, has different -- just runs differently.

They also have an accreditation program for POST agencies, or our board side of functions, which will evaluate your policies and procedures, staffing, all of that. I think it would be something that would certainly benefit us to get involved with on both fronts.

But, again, it -- it involves funding. It involves staffing. But it was a wonderful experience, and I hope we can work more with it.

As far as our special meeting last -- on August 19th, I was very hopeful after that. I greatly appreciated the Board's input in getting that moved forward.





That budget was submitted on August 23rd.

DPS met with the Governor's Office and DFA to

present the NMLEA Board budget, as well as the other

expansion budgets that DPS wanted to request.

And on that date, they received approval to submit the requests, which was very hopeful. And until last evening, when I got a call and had less than an hour, I was told that -- I was directed that that -- that the Governor's Office had made a request, and said that that budget needed to be cut by 50 percent before it would be submitted.

So in approximately 15 minutes, I had to go through and -- and cut out FTEs for it to be -- before it would be submitted.

So I'm going to try and share -- I want to show you what I submitted so you-all can be aware of it.

Are you all able to see that?

MR. ROMERO: Yes, Madam Director. We can see it.

DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Okay. This is the FTA, the personnel cost listing that were in the presentation I gave at the special meeting. The positions that are in black are the positions that remained on the request, and the positions in red



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are the positions that needed to be cut to meet the financial request.

And my only theory for doing it is because the -- those positions that are remaining handle the core function of the staffing duties of the Board. It gives you the administrative function of the director; the compliance officer positions, which handle all of the compliance issues, data that comes in; and one executive secretary to help with all of the administrative paperwork; and the state investigator, which is the current misconduct case processor.

 $\,$ And so that is -- is what was forwarded as the request.

So I'm a little disheartened with that, because everything that we're moving forward in a positive direction, at some point I just feel like I'm beating my head against a wall. I don't know what else -- I don't know how to get to follow up on what the Chair has said that, you know, this isn't just a little board, and the academy isn't just a little administrative function.

They are -- we need the funding, and we need the staff to do it. I think the Board and I think DPS, as the academy's division attachment, all



recognize that. And I don't know how to get through that we can't continue to do what we're doing for either entity, for the Board or the academy, what is expected to do.

Several years ago, within the last 10 to 20 years, this staffing here was 30 people. And it handled -- I won't say it handled -- but it was responsible for the functions of both entities.

And we are now down to 19, but have been operating at about 10. And it's just past the point of realistic.

And the staff is wonderful. The staff you have working with you is unbelievable. Most of them are doing two to three full-time jobs. And they're not just, you know, entry-level positions. They're positions that have taken these people -- you know, they're -- they know what they're doing. They're specialty positions, and they keep things running.

But we can't continue to do this. And it's disheartening. We're not giving up. We're not giving up. But it's disheartening.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you, Director.

DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Yes. That's my --

A.G. BALDERAS: Did you have more on your report, or did you save the most sad for last in

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your report?

2 DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: No. That wraps it

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A.G. BALDERAS: Okay. Thank you. Well,

I -- I encourage you to maybe reach out to the Board

and -- you know, this information is kind of new to

us, in terms of we just heard this information that

that was more the recommendation.

And so I think -- I think -- I think the Board -- well, at least I speak for myself -- we definitely want to have more conversations to see if, you know -- I -- let me say this way:

As an executive who has his own agency woes with budget, there will be other opportunities, I think. The budget process involves many stakeholders. And so I think while this may be an earlier recommendation, the recommendations and the process can evolve very quickly.

And so I would say that my advice, in terms of our board, is our input last meeting was -- is still consistent. I think now the question is how do we continue to convey the Board's commitment to increased resources at these levels? You know, what is the best way to proactively work with the powers that be?



I do want to kind of take Chairman's privilege as part of my early report. I want to welcome our two new members, Chief Mirabal of Taos, and Benny Roybal is also our public member. We want to welcome you.

I, because I prosecute cases, while I chair the policy and the fiscal management and direction of the Board, I'm really the -- we could not do the discipline work and the training directives without public members and law enforcement members serving on the Board. And so I want to thank our two new members for being willing to serve.

And because even I and the police chief cannot completely execute all the functions of the Board, we really lean on our leadership of our individual members.

And so, one, I want to thank you-all for putting in the time commitment, and then also express some gratitude on me -- on my behalf and the Chief of State Police for also filling in in a leadership role.

Because we have investigative and prosecutorial functions over sometimes officer issues, we generally abstain from what I think is



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the most critical point of the Board. 1 And so I do want to thank Mr. Roybal and 2 3 Chief Mirabal for being willing to serve. And they 4 are new members, so I wanted to welcome them. 5 And if they want to say a few words now 6 before we go into Public Comment, I would welcome 7 that as well. Good morning, everyone. 8 CHIEF MIRABAL: 9 I'd just like to say thank you. And I look forward 10 to working with you-all. I'm excited for this 11 position. Thank you. 12 A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you, Chief. 13 MR. ROYBAL: This is Benny Roybal. I, as well, would like to thank you-all. I am looking 14 forward to working with you-all, and anything that I 15 16 can work on and help, I am here to serve. 17 Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you. Appreciate our new members.

And then -- and then every now and then, I know -- because we -- there's historical issues, legislative issues, there's unique roles that each Board Member plays. And so please feel free to reach out to the Director or to our staff. If we can provide you any historical information so that



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you feel like you can kind of actively participate, we welcome that as -- we're at your beck and call, as you need information to acclimate yourself to your Board role.

A.G. BALDERAS: Now I'd like to go to Public Comment.

I do see Mr. Mechels. Are there any -- oh, Mr. -- Sheriff, you had your hand up.

Mr. Mendoza?

SHERIFF MENDOZA: Can I make a comment,
Mr. Chair, in reference, before we move on to Public
Comment? I feel obligated as the sheriff
representation for New Mexico, I recently attended a
sheriffs' mini-conference with all the sheriffs and
undersheriffs, and there was a lot of representation
from the State of New Mexico.

But I wanted to bring up some of the concerns that I heard at this meeting. And one of the main concern is -- and I know it comes back to staffing, but I think it's also -- goes back to the role of the Law Enforcement Academy and -- and -- and so a lot of the concerns that I heard was the fact that -- was the lack of support from the Law Enforcement Academy when it comes to advanced training and training in general.



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And I've personally seen that as a law enforcement agency. And I'm here in Santa Fe. It used to be that there was a schedule of advanced training that the Law Enforcement Academy would put out to offer to local law enforcement agencies throughout the State of New Mexico to kind of cut down on costs of bringing in instructors from out of state or sending people to get trained to train their own departments.

And I think one of the concern is is that there's lack of advanced training being offered by the Law Enforcement Academy.

And I think it's an opportunity for us as a board and the Law Enforcement Academy to put out some of those advanced trainings in ways of de-escalation and things that we would like to see standardized throughout the state for a minimal cost to local law enforcement agencies.

And I know it's a staffing issue, and it comes back to staffing, and I'm sure what the Director would say in answer to my question. Or maybe not; but -- she's shaking her head.

But the fact of the matter is, is I think there's some frustration there, from at least the sheriff's office and some of the sheriffs. And I



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1	know sometimes the Law Enforcement Academy does rely
2	on us for instructors to help with some of the
3	academies. And I think it should be the opposite.
4	We should be relying on the Law Enforcement Academy
5	to help with instruction throughout the state.
6	I just wanted to make that comment because
7	I felt obligated because of those concerns that I
8	heard.
9	A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you, Sheriff.
10	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Chair?
11	A.G. BALDERAS: Yeah. Would you like to
12	respond, Director?
13	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Yes. Thank you for
14	sharing that input.
15	I was working with the sheriffs'
16	association for several months prior to this meeting
17	to get confirmation. I had requested and offered to
18	be down there to answer any questions and was told
19	it would happen, but consistently did not receive
20	any follow-up as far as as far as coming and
21	doing that.
22	So I appreciate you sharing what was
23	shared there.
24	The main reason there hasn't been advanced
25	training is because of COVID, is when the academy



shut down, we can't bring people up here. The advanced training that was hosted is hosted here at the academy, so agencies can come to a central point.

Staffing would certainly be tough. But right up until June 30th, when we were allowed to kind of reopen again, we couldn't bring that many people here to do it.

Our intent was to start scheduling training and moving on. But as -- as everything has kind of gone back to being difficult with COVID, we're looking at doing that, but doing it within the confines of -- of the regulations and guidelines we're given.

So that -- and agencies have been told that. Sheriffs' agencies, police departments have been told that that's -- that's the main reason why anything hasn't been offered here right now.

And it's our intent -- it is our function -- it's the academy's function to provide that training. And it's at the top of our priority list to get that training back up and running again.

SHERIFF MENDOZA: Thank you. That's further clarification.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you, Sheriff.

21	A.G. BALDERAS: Great. If you would walk
22	us through that, we'd appreciate it.
23	DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Yes. Item No. 7 is
24	Law Enforcement Officer Certifications.
25	Item A, which would be Exhibit A, is



Western New Mexico University BPOT No. 66. 1 2 Exhibit A. And that's Certification No. 21-0208-P. 3 A.G. BALDERAS: And, Madam Chair, does 4 that exhibit -- you said B? Not A? Or you said A? 5 Not B? Does that end at -258-P? 6 DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: I only read Item A, 7 which is Exhibit A. And I can move on to Exhibit B. I just --8 9 A.G. BALDERAS: No. I guess -- I'm trying 10 to find my Exhibit A. It may be my binder. 11 see Exhibit A in the cover letter. But I'm not --12 am I the only Board Member that's having this issue 13 in terms of Exhibit A? Locating Exhibit A? 14 Oh, my bad. My bad. 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ITEM NO. 4: CHAIR'S REPORT

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A.G. BALDERAS: We can now go to the --Item No. 4 is Chairman's Report. My report is rather brief.

I would like to maybe address a couple of issues that I think we've been dealing with over the course of everyone's tenure on the Board. I'd like to maybe follow up and -- and request from the Director, maybe at the next meeting, just an update, or a follow-up if, the director is adequately prepared to give an update today, I'd rather maybe push it to the next meeting.

But I do think that the Board would benefit from the follow-up on the progress of the biennium training requirements relating to the database. I know there was a lot of discussion and a lot of good work moving in the right direction to modernize the database. And so I think, you know, at a later date -- or, rather, isolated or detailed update -- would be helpful.

Additionally, I know that there is considerable support for the -- from the Board to identify personnel classifications and understaffing challenges. I know that's a common theme from the Director and management. And so if there's anything special request for more prosecutors in the enforcement of these -- of these case actions that come over to our office.

And then, finally, I guess, you know, I want to maybe continue our focus. Many past boards have had the -- sometimes the -- both the privilege, and sometimes the luxury, of just focusing on training issues and on licensing issues and discipline issues. But as all of us have, you know, followed the news, and even last meeting, while the Board was serving and the Director was providing information and reporting on standard issues, there was an emergency situation in Albuquerque. That's where Sergeant Anderson and the Chief were called out in an active shooting situation.

And so these -- these issues, it would be good, by the end of the year, to -- and I know I have appointed a subcommittee. But I do think that any law enforcement reform or criminal justice reform that the Legislature either considers or evaluates, you know, I'm real hopeful that the Board, in a unified manner, we can provide our feedback and input on some of these bills and legislative.

I do think that there is going to be more

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that can be identified where we can be more supportive -- and, of course, obviously, last discussion was very helpful in -- in really trying to build out a stronger system so that we can support, really, mitigating or minimizing a backlog of cases, not just in the investigation, but even at the AG's office, we have experienced, you know, volumes of cases. Some months, we'll get no cases; other months, we'll get a referral of 25 cases at once.

So I do think if we can keep that dialogue, Director, and, if -- again, if it's more appropriate at the next meeting, I think that the Board is definitely hungry for ways that we can be more supportive in those areas.

Finally, I know that coming in the session, Director, it would be really productive and helpful, we're anxious to see how the budget process is looking. I know there were some deadlines last couple of weeks. But as we get closer to LFC recommendations in January, it will be helpful to get some updates on the special appropriation request, especially for the job task analysis.

And then I'll also make my staff -- or request my staff give the Board an update on our attention given. But it would be a real travesty if this board didn't feel compelled to at least weigh in.

And I'm not asking for a lot of time commitment, and I'm not asking for a lot of research and diligence. But it would be nice for the Board for us to -- at least to decide what we're unified on in terms of where there should be increased resources, and maybe some ideas and legislation that the -- that are prioritized.

And so I just think that this board has a lot of experience. And I do think that -- and my staff is willing to synthesize and just take your input and maybe try to synthesize it into a position paper or a letter from our Board just identifying for the Governor and the Legislature areas of need that -- so I offer that up.

And I just think, in the Chair's Report, that -- that, regrettably -- I don't think you can separate licensing issues; I don't think you can separate law enforcement staffing levels; and I don't think you can address training in a vacuum when you consider other reforms.

> And so that's just my pitch to the Board. If Jerri calls you or, you know, tries to

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poll you on your interest on certain ideas, please, you know, speak freely. We'll protect your -- your professional integrity. But what we're trying to do is synthesize and maybe create a letter before January to just broadly call attention some blind spots that the Legislature might not be considering.

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Because the LEAB, I think, is one of the most important functions, and, yet, I think there's a lot of mystery as to our process. But I really think you are all leaders in -- in these very difficult topic areas that I think now, for some reason, the Legislature, I think, is going to go the opposite direction.

And I think they're going to -- they're going to be rather aggressive in trying to make changes or -- and I just want to make sure the LEAB is at the very top of respected authorities that -- based on your experience as to seeing patterns of law enforcement misconduct or where you've seen training needs, I think you guys are subject matter experts right off the bat.

So it's going to be up to me and my staff to kind of figure out what the priorities are of the Board. But I think, regrettably, we're in an era where I think the LEAB can no longer be considered should focus.

So without that -- with all of that, I should say -- I'll now move us along to the Director's Report.

And you have the floor, Director.

ITEM NO. 5: DIRECTOR'S REPORT

DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Thank you, Chair. I
 can touch on each of those topics briefly right now.
 But if you'd prefer, I can have something more

prepared for next meeting.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you.

DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: The biennial training update, working with ACADIS, it's just slow going. We've gotten things that we now know that -- that we can do and the program can do. But our staffing is -- is slowing it down.

If there is a glitch in the system -- I can give you an example. We -- when we -- after a meeting, after you-all have ratified certifications, so we go to e-mail those certifications out. And this last time around, half of the people don't get them.

And it's not a glitch with the database. It's the interaction between the database and the 193 different agencies who have different IT setups.

just a ministerial function that the Legislature or other areas are unaware of this very function.

I think -- I think this Board is probably one of the most important boards, especially when you talk about funding or public safety demands, on both sides, for citizens, and also what you want law enforcement to look like in 10, 15, 20 years.

You all are the experts, I think. And I just don't see how we can just focus on our licensing and our discipline issues and stay silent. I think it would be a very big travesty if we don't somehow put out, before January, just some kind of solidarity or areas of need that we -- we have observed ourselves.

And I think -- I think that's my pitch. So that's -- that's -- Jerri and my staff will probably be reaching out to you as we get closer to the legislative session coming up in January.

That's fairly all. I just wanted to convey our support to the law enforcement community, in the past month, in the demands that have been occurring in the State of New Mexico, and then just give everyone a courtesy that we might be reaching out just to -- to synthesize a legislative agenda maybe in terms of what areas that the Legislature

We don't have an IT person here. And if something like that happens, our deputy director basically has to stop everything he's doing. And this has been since early July was the first one. And I've got three or four staff members that just do that, that are doing three or four jobs. And to do -- to focus on putting out a fire that needs to be addressed right then, then literally everything else they're doing stops.

So the program is awesome. We're getting a lot of forward-moving progress on the ability to track stuff. It's now just that we don't have the staff to make it all happen.

After we initiated getting the agencies the capability to enter their rosters and update them, we had a backlog of other 4,000 entries, because everybody started entering them. And they have to be reviewed and verified initially. Once the process gets going, they can upload. But those are just two examples of what the staffing issues are causing.

I think the other -- the other ones, I'll wait and give you a better -- a more in-depth update at the next meeting.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you.

DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Currently, our hiring, we're still in hiring processes for instructors, a training coordinator, a compliance officer, and a misconduct case manager position.

One of those positions -- I apologize, it's either the instructor or the case manager position -- was frozen at the end of -- of the fiscal year, June 30th. So we can't hire that one until it's unfrozen.

I traveled last week. I was in Kosovo and then North Macedonia. I was working with IADLEST. I am the accreditation committee chair.

And we handle two different areas of accreditation. We accredit police academies like ours, or standards, best practices, that we go in and audit agencies who have requested to receive that accreditation. It works here in the United States, but we also have international academies who request that.

So I was part of a group that went over and did the audit functions for the Kosovo police department and the North Macedonia police department.

And I was thankful for the opportunity to do that, because a lot of the theory that we work

That budget was submitted on August 23rd. DPS met with the Governor's Office and DFA to present the NMLEA Board budget, as well as the other expansion budgets that DPS wanted to request.

And on that date, they received approval to submit the requests, which was very hopeful. And until last evening, when I got a call and had less than an hour, I was told that -- I was directed that that -- that the Governor's Office had made a request, and said that that budget needed to be cut by 50 percent before it would be submitted.

So in approximately 15 minutes, I had to go through and -- and cut out FTEs for it to be -- before it would be submitted.

So I'm going to try and share -- I want to show you what I submitted so you-all can be aware of it

Are you all able to see that?

MR. ROMERO: Yes, Madam Director. We can see it.

DIRECTOR ALZAHARNA: Okay. This is the FTA, the personnel cost listing that were in the presentation I gave at the special meeting. The positions that are in black are the positions that remained on the request, and the positions in red

off of and what we think is important here, it was good to put it into practice and to see how those evaluations and audits are done.

Both of those agencies did receive accreditation. The Kosovo agency received an award of excellence for meeting the standards.

In that context, it's tough to meet those standards. It's something I would like to do for our academy and put that out as an option to our satellite academies, because each of them would have to apply individually, because their academy, you know, has different -- just runs differently.

They also have an accreditation program for POST agencies, or our board side of functions, which will evaluate your policies and procedures, staffing, all of that. I think it would be something that would certainly benefit us to get involved with on both fronts.

But, again, it -- it involves funding. It involves staffing. But it was a wonderful experience, and I hope we can work more with it.

As far as our special meeting last -- on August 19th, I was very hopeful after that. I greatly appreciated the Board's input in getting that moved forward.

are the positions that needed to be cut to meet the financial request.

And my only theory for doing it is because the -- those positions that are remaining handle the core function of the staffing duties of the Board. It gives you the administrative function of the director; the compliance officer positions, which handle all of the compliance issues, data that comes in; and one executive secretary to help with all of the administrative paperwork; and the state investigator, which is the current misconduct case processor.

And so that is -- is what was forwarded as the request.

So I'm a little disheartened with that, because everything that we're moving forward in a positive direction, at some point I just feel like I'm beating my head against a wall. I don't know what else -- I don't know how to get to follow up on what the Chair has said that, you know, this isn't just a little board, and the academy isn't just a little administrative function.

They are -- we need the funding, and we need the staff to do it. I think the Board and I think DPS, as the academy's division attachment, all

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recognize that. And I don't know how to get through that we can't continue to do what we're doing for either entity, for the Board or the academy, what is expected to do.

Several years ago, within the last 10 to 20 years, this staffing here was 30 people. And it handled -- I won't say it handled -- but it was responsible for the functions of both entities.

And we are now down to 19, but have been operating at about 10. And it's just past the point of realistic.

And the staff is wonderful. The staff you have working with you is unbelievable. Most of them are doing two to three full-time jobs. And they're not just, you know, entry-level positions. They're positions that have taken these people -- you know, they're -- they know what they're doing. They're specialty positions, and they keep things running.

But we can't continue to do this. And it's disheartening. We're not giving up. We're not giving up. But it's disheartening.

And because even I and the police chief cannot completely execute all the functions of the Board, we really lean on our leadership of our individual members.

And so, one, I want to thank you-all for putting in the time commitment, and then also express some gratitude on me -- on my behalf and the Chief of State Police for also filling in in a leadership role.

Because we have investigative and prosecutorial functions over sometimes officer issues, we generally abstain from what I think is

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1 the most critical point of the Board.

And so I do want to thank Mr. Roybal and Chief Mirabal for being willing to serve. And they are new members, so I wanted to welcome them.

And if they want to say a few words now before we go into Public Comment, I would welcome that as well.

CHIEF MIRABAL: Good morning, everyone. I'd just like to say thank you. And I look forward to working with you-all. I'm excited for this position. Thank you.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you, Chief. MR. ROYBAL: This is Benny Roybal. I, as well, would like to thank you-all. I am looking forward to working with you-all, and anything that I can work on and help, I am here to serve.

Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

A.G. BALDERAS: Thank you. Appreciate our new members.

And then -- and then every now and then, I know -- because we -- there's historical issues, legislative issues, there's unique roles that each Board Member plays. And so please feel free to reach out to the Director or to our staff. If we can provide you any historical information so that

I think now the question is how do we continue to convey the Board's commitment to increased resources at these levels? You know, what is the best way to proactively work with the powers that be?

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you feel like you can kind of actively participate, we welcome that as -- we're at your beck and call, as you need information to acclimate yourself to your Board role.

And one of the main concern is -- and I know it comes back to staffing, but I think it's also -- goes back to the role of the Law Enforcement Academy and -- and -- and so a lot of the concerns that I heard was the fact that -- was the lack of support from the Law Enforcement Academy when it comes to advanced training and training in general.

1 know sometimes the Law Enforcement Academy does rely 2 on us for instructors to help with some of the

academies. And I think it should be the opposite.

We should be relying on the Law Enforcement Academy to help with instruction throughout the state.

I just wanted to make that comment because I felt obligated because of those concerns that I heard.

The main reason there hasn't been advanced training is because of COVID, is when the academy

And I've personally seen that as a law enforcement agency. And I'm here in Santa Fe. It used to be that there was a schedule of advanced training that the Law Enforcement Academy would put out to offer to local law enforcement agencies throughout the State of New Mexico to kind of cut down on costs of bringing in instructors from out of state or sending people to get trained to train their own departments.

And I think one of the concern is is that there's lack of advanced training being offered by the Law Enforcement Academy.

And I think it's an opportunity for us as a board and the Law Enforcement Academy to put out some of those advanced trainings in ways of de-escalation and things that we would like to see standardized throughout the state for a minimal cost to local law enforcement agencies.

And I know it's a staffing issue, and it comes back to staffing, and I'm sure what the Director would say in answer to my question. Or maybe not; but -- she's shaking her head.

But the fact of the matter is, is I think there's some frustration there, from at least the sheriffs office and some of the sheriffs. And I

shut down, we can't bring people up here. The advanced training that was hosted is hosted here at the academy, so agencies can come to a central point.

Staffing would certainly be tough. But right up until June 30th, when we were allowed to kind of reopen again, we couldn't bring that many people here to do it.

Our intent was to start scheduling training and moving on. But as -- as everything has kind of gone back to being difficult with COVID, we're looking at doing that, but doing it within the confines of -- of the regulations and guidelines we're given.

So that -- and agencies have been told that. Sheriffs' agencies, police departments have been told that that's -- that's the main reason why anything hasn't been offered here right now.

And it's our intent -- it is our function -- it's the academy's function to provide that training. And it's at the top of our priority list to get that training back up and running again.
