Senator Antonio “Moe” Maestas- “My name is Antonio Maestas, or Mo Maestas, a state senator from Albuquerque, and I was the roundhouse leader this afternoon, so I figured I'd just stop by and say hi. I just want to perfectly thank each and every one of you for your commitment to this board, your commitment to law enforcement. You guys have big wheel jobs and tons of responsibilities in your own right, and then just to volunteer for this board is just tremendous.

I just want to thank you all for doing that. It's like all new state institutions, there's growing things. It's unfortunate that some of this stuff is going to be hashed out in the courts, but by all means, don't worry about any of that stuff.

That stuff will be played out by folks outside of this room, and just keep doing what you're doing. I'm committed to doing law enforcement bills. I've been doing them for almost 20 years since I've been a lawmaker, and each and every year, we can tweak the statutes and just make these institutions stronger, make law enforcement stronger.

We now have the resources as state government, financially, to accomplish all of our dreams, all of our dreams. You know, I dream of a law enforcement academy that rivals that of the FBI in terms of facility, so my dream is that every police officer, every deputy has the best possible training, accountability, and then not only can that particular officer or deputy learn from this kind of delegations, but the entire force and their colleagues can all learn from those same examples, whether they're suspended or not. Each, it's like football.

Everything's on video. You could walk deputies and officers through these moments and

Vice-Chair Cody Rogers provided an update on the Rules Working Groups, noting that she oversees the Misconduct Rules Working Group, and Board Member Julie Ball oversees the Certification Qualifications and Issuance Rules Working Group.

Vice-Chair Cody Rogers reported that while the working group had anticipated presenting a final draft of the rule revisions for initiation, a recent review identified typographical errors, grammatical issues, formatting concerns, and language inconsistencies. She also noted that some previously discussed revisions may not have been incorporated into the most recent version circulated to the Board. As a result, additional review and editing are necessary before presenting the rules for initiation.

Board Counsel Marianne Bowers advised that typographical and grammatical corrections could be made after initiation if they are purely technical in nature. However, Vice-Chair Cody Rogers explained that the draft contains additional substantive inconsistencies that warrant further review to ensure the document accurately reflects the working group's intended revisions.

Vice-Chair Cody Rogers stated that the working group intends to use the additional time to finalize the draft and present a completed version for Board consideration at the next regular meeting.

Board Member Julie Ball added that the working group hopes to distribute the revised draft to Board members approximately one week prior to the next meeting to allow sufficient time for review and discussion before consideration of initiation.

- III. Report on current staffing/recruiting efforts.

Operations Officer Ivan Ramirez-Arechiga provided an update regarding staffing and recruitment efforts for the Law Enforcement Certification Board. He reported that vacant positions are being posted through the standard state hiring process and are generally advertised for 10 to 14 days to allow applicants sufficient time to review job descriptions and submit applications.

Mr. Ramirez-Arechiga advised that recruitment efforts for the Management Support Staff and Law Clerk positions were progressing and that qualified candidates had been identified through the interview and selection process. He explained that these positions were pending completion of Human Resources procedures and the issuance of formal employment offers.

Mr. Ramirez-Arechiga further reported that the Board was exploring alternative recruitment options for the Chief Executive Officer position through a Request for Proposals (RFP) process for contract services. Vice-Chair Cody Rogers noted that utilizing a contract model may make the position more attractive to qualified candidates, including retirees who may be interested in continuing public service. She stated that the RFP was expected to be released that week and that a panel would be established to evaluate responses and make recommendations.

Vice-Chair Cody Rogers also discussed the Board's ongoing assessment of staffing needs, noting that operational experience has shown that some positions originally envisioned at the Board's formation may require adjustments to better align with the Board's actual workload, responsibilities, and operational requirements.

The Board considered Agenda Item regarding the ratification and approval of pending law enforcement officer certifications by waiver listed in Exhibit A. It was noted that there were no Exhibit B for Public Safety Telecommunicator certifications at this meeting due to the Board's transition to a monthly meeting schedule.

Board member Joseph Walsh inquired whether the applicants listed in Exhibit A had completed all requirements necessary for certification by waiver and how compliance had been verified. Staff confirmed that all required verification had been completed and that the applicants met the applicable certification requirements.
